# **OTC Fluoride Mouth Rinses**

# PURPOSE/USE

- Remineralizes and protects enamel
- Prevents cavities
- Freshens breath
- Use if cavity prone or if demineralized lesions are present (Enerback et al., 2023)
- Use 1x daily after flossing & brushing
- Follow directions on packaging for swish times. Typically 1 minute using 10ml.

# CAUTION

• Avoid rinses containing alcohol, can

# ACTIVE INGREDIENT

- 0.02-0.05% Sodium fluoride
- \*0.02% is FDA approved

to use once weekly!

### cause irritation, enamel/dentinal damage, and xerostomia due to acidity (Darby & Walsh, 2014)

- Do not eat or drink for 30 min after rinsing, prevents benefits of fluoride
- Doesn't replace fluoride toothpaste
