
XEROSTOMIA

Definition

Xerostomia, commonly referred to as dry mouth, is a condition characterized by a sensation of reduced or absent saliva production.





Active Ingredients

- Xylitol
- Acacia gum
- Cellulose gum
- Magnesium stearate
- Sodium bicarbonate
- Calcium carbonate

Mechanism

Increases salivary flow which helps combat dry mouth

Instructions for use

• Apply the melt to the gum line on the outer side of an upper or lower molar, ensuring the white side faces your cheek. Use your tongue to adjust the melt to a comfortable position. Allow it to sit undisturbed for 10 seconds to ensure proper adhesion.



- 2 melts (1.5 g)
- Use 3 to 5 times per day or as needed



Recommendations

-Recommended for patients who have dry mouth -It coats, lubricates, and soothes.

Active Ingredients

- Xylitol
- Sorbitol
- Poloxamer 407
- Sodium Phosphate
- Disodium Phosphate



Mechanism

This mint-flavored oral rinse provides long-lasting relief from dry mouth, keeping your mouth hydrated for up to 4 hours.

Instructions for use

- Use 15ml (approx. one tablespoon)
- Rinse for 30 secs then spit out
- Use up to 2- 3 times per day only on the instruction of your healthcare profesional

- Allows patients to be more comfortable while drinking, chewing, and speaking.
- Allows instant relief from mouth sores caused by radiation treatment or cancer chemotherapy.


