

Parts of Speech: (the names of grammar)

PART OF SPEECH	DEFINITION	EXAMPLE
common noun	person, place, or thing	children, city, store, student, teacher, school,
proper noun	the name of the person, place, or thing	Araceli, Tacoma, Safeway, Ana, Luis, CPTC
pronoun	a word used in the place of a noun	she, mine, our, it, I, you, we, they, he
article	a word used in front of a noun	a, an, the
verb	a word that tells the action or state	Speak, study, write, go, do, jump, dance, walk, run, eat, drink, watch, read
adjective	a word that describes a noun	Good, bad, big, small, yellow, beautiful, blue, black, red, ugly,



adverb	a word that describes a verb or adjective, or tells how, where, when, and how often	Always, never, sometimes, later, carefully, beautifully, quickly
preposition	a word that gives information about a time or place	On, in, at, from, between, over, under, above, below, after
conjunction	a word that connects two sentences together	And, but, because

Types of Pronouns

subject pronoun	Can replace the subject.	I, you, he, she, it, we, they
possessive pronoun	Tell us the person who owns the thing - possession / ownership	My, your, his, her, its, our, their + NOUN This is my book.
		NO NOUN Mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs This book is mine.
object pronoun	Tells us who the action is to/towards	Me, you, him, her, it, us, them



What is a subject?

Subjects do the action

They can be nouns or pronouns

Ex: Rosa is in class. She is listening.

The teacher is reading a book to us. My class is interesting.

What is a verb?

Action or state of being

What is an object?

The object receives/gets the action

Ex: The teacher is reading a book to us.
